

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARKING:

The Baltimore 10 Miler crosses the city via 28th Street twice so 28th is shut down for most of the morning. The race commences at 7:30 am and the runners start in four waves spaced about 3 minutes apart. This puts the final wave start time at about 7:45 am. Runners are limited to a three hour completion time so the latest a runner can return to Druid Hill park is 10:45. This puts the last stragglers in our area at about 10:00-10:15 as the intersection of Charles and 28th is about 2.5 miles from the finish line. Traffic should be flowing pretty well by that time so there should really be no problem accessing the lot by the time you are finished setting up.

The Vendor parking lot is located on the grounds of the Johns Hopkins University School of Education which is found just southwest of the intersection of Charles and 29th Streets. Entrances to this parking lot are located on 28th Street and on Charles Street.

To access this lot from the festival grounds, travel west on 29th street from Charles Street. Make your first left onto Maryland avenue. Travel south to the next intersection at 28th Street and make another left. The 28th Street entrance to the parking lot will be your first left. If you pass this entrance, make your next left onto Charles Street and the Charles Street entrance will be the following left.

As always parking is free.
